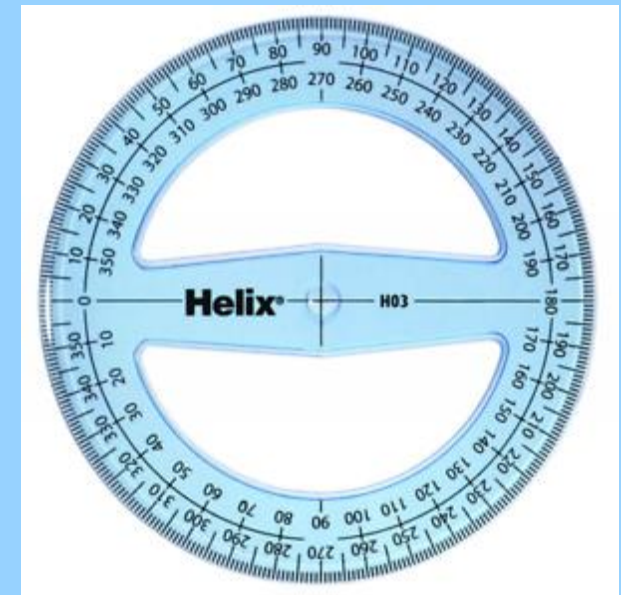
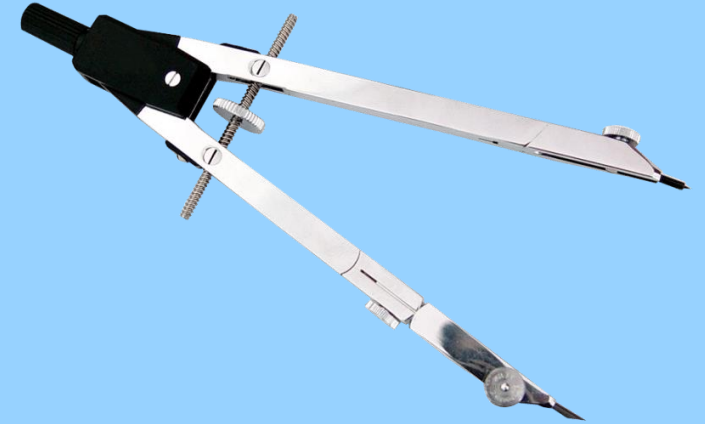
# Essential Equipment
